Course Name	Intended Trainees	Course Objective
Operation 1	who has no operation experience of the equipment	To enable trainees to understand the terms necessary for operating the equipment and to process products by calling up data sets in the equipment
Operation 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • who has already completed the "Operation 1" course (or has equivalent operation skills) • who creates and sets data, and sets up the functions of the equipment 	To enable trainees to create and set data, and to set up the functions for operating the equipment
Maintenance 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • who has already completed the "Operation 2" course (or has equivalent operation skills) • who performs periodic maintenance and replacement of consumable parts of the equipment 	To enable trainees to precisely and safely perform periodic maintenance and replacement of consumable parts as described in the Maintenance Manual of the equipment
Maintenance 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • who has already completed the "Maintenance 1" course (or has equivalent maintenance skills) • who conducts maintenance tasks which are not described in the Maintenance Manual of the equipment 	To enable trainees to conduct maintenance tasks which are not described in the Maintenance Manual of the equipment (only items that can be executed without the use of any special tools or access to internal maker data)
